## **Instructions:**

- Print off two copies of the main sheet. (page 1)
- Laminate one copy or put inside a plastic seal-top folder. This is your reference sheet (OR you could always print a copy for each show on paper and just cross the scents through as you draw them)
- Take the second copy and cut it up into scent blocks.
- Put all of the cut up pieces into a little gift bag/box this is your "bingo drum"!
- Print off the game cards obviously add to them I've started you off with eight. As long as the scents are all different on each card you shouldn't have any probs!
- At your show, tell your guests you are going to play Scent Sampler Bingo!
- Each guest has a bingo card.
- Grab everyone's attention and tell them that there is a small prize for the first to get three in a line either horizontally, vertically or diagonally. Perhaps give a wrapped votive or something similar to that guest who gets there first.
- Reach into your bag/box and draw out the individual 'scents' and first read
  the comment and encourage them to join in (i.e. when singing Happy
  Birthday, blowing raspberries, saying Oooh La La!) then read the
  FRAGRANCE! If the guest has that Fragrance on their sheet, they cross it
  through.
- As you draw the Scent out, then place it over your laminated copy so that you know that particular item has been called out and no-one is cheating!
- You could extend the game by going for a "full house" which would be the first person to fill their card! Perhaps have a larger gift for a full house depends how much time you have. Only accept the first three in a row then the next prize will be the full house!
- Hope this works for you!! It's a great ice breaker!!
